HY PITT MEMORIAL ADULT EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

1.0 SCHOLARSHIP NAME

The name of the scholarship shall be the Hy Pitt Memorial Adult Education Scholarship. This scholarship replaces the former Milwaukee Section Student Branch Scholarship.

2.0 NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS PROVIDED

Each year, one scholarship shall be awarded for up to 20 valid applications. If more than twenty valid applications are received, additional scholarships shall be awarded for each multiple of twenty, i.e. 2 scholarships for 21 – 40 applications, 3 for 41 – 60 to a maximum of three scholarships.

3.0 AMOUNT OF EACH SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of each scholarship shall be \$1000.00, unless changed by proper vote of the Sections leadership team. Funding shall be provided from proceeds from the Section's investments (e.g. CD's).

4.0 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be a Regular Member, a Student Member, an Associate Member, or a Forum/Divisions member, attending a school in Dodge, Fond du Lac, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Sheboygan, Washington, or Waukesha counties. The requirement for attendance in the seven-county area is waived for members with a Milwaukee Section affiliation;
2. Applicant must have attended 5 monthly dinner meetings within the last year;
3. Applicant must be a member of the Leadership Team, or an active member on a standing committee.
4. Applicant must provide a written Statement of Contribution to Career Objectives and Development, answering the following questions:
 - How will the money be used (name of the course or educational activity, including the course provider)?
 - How will it benefit you (personally)?
 - How will it benefit your company, now or in the future?The written statement shall be in 12 point type, double spaced, with 1 inch top, bottom and side margins.
5. Past winners are eligible to reapply for the current year;

5.0 APPLICATION METHOD

Applications are available at asqmilwaukee.org. The application must be completed and post marked no later than June 24th, and must be accompanied by objective evidence of participation in ASQ activities, and the Statement of Contribution to Career Objectives and Development.

Acceptable objective evidence of participation in ASQ activities include:

- Leadership Team Organization chart showing committees or offices
- Letters from the Section Chair or Standing Committee Chair, indicating active participation
- Verification of Monthly Meeting Attendance forms provided by the Section

6.0 SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

Each July, the Section Chair shall appoint a HY Pitt Memorial Adult Education Scholarship Committee Chair, and sufficient committee members, based on the number of applications received. The applications shall be reviewed and verified by a committee member. Applications determined to not meet the criteria shall be verified by an additional committee member. Any discrepancies will be resolved by the committee chair.

7.0 AWARDING OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship winner(s) will be determined by a lottery draw, from all applications meeting the eligibility requirements, at the September regular Section Meeting.

The Scholarship winners(s) will be invited to the October Regular Meeting as guests of the Section, at which time the Award will be presented. The actual scholarship funds will be sent to the winner upon proof of registration for the current semester or enrolment in an education course in agreement with the submitted Statement of Contribution to Career Objectives and Development.
